

STOCKPORT PARTNERSHIP CONSTITUTION: AMENDMENTS**Report of the Head of Policy and Scrutiny, Stockport Council****1.0 Background**

- 1.1 The draft Partnership Handbook was approved at the previous meeting of the Partnership Board, subject to clarification of the status of the Greater Manchester Fire and Rescue Service. Finalisation of the list was also subject to the outcome of the joint health planning review.

2.0 Proposed amendments to the Partnership Constitution

- 2.1 Two amendments are proposed as follows:
- Adding the Greater Manchester Fire and Rescue Service to the list of members.
 - Updating the membership list to reflect the outcome of the joint health planning review i.e. establishment of the Health and Well Being Partnership (replacing the Stockport Health Improvement Partnership).
- 2.2 The relevant abridged extract from the Stockport partnership Constitution (page 10):

- One place each for representatives nominated by each of the thematic partnerships:
 - Children and Young Peoples Strategic Partnership
 - Safer Stockport Partnership
 - Stronger Communities Partnership
 - **Stockport Health and Well Being Partnership (updated)**
 - Stockport Economic Alliance
 - Stockport Learning and Skills Partnership

3.0 Recommendation

- 3.1 The Stockport Partnership Board is asked to agree the two amendments outlined in 2.0 above.
